

# Government-Funded Child-Rearing Support Allowance to Address Rising Prices

Receive a one-time payment of **20,000 yen** per eligible child!

## ■ Firstly... do I need to apply?

In principle, **you do not need to apply**.

Note: For those who need to apply, see "6" on the back.

(i) The support allowance notice will be sent to you.

(ii) If you do not wish to receive the allowance or if you would like to change the receiving bank account, contact the help desk shown on the back by the application deadline shown on the notice.

(iii) The allowance will be transferred to the same bank account used for receiving child allowances.

Note: If you fall under "6" on the back, submit an application.

△ Situations where, as a general rule, no application is required (excluding public servants):

- \* If you received child allowance for September 2025, or
- \* If you receive child allowance for your child/children who was/were born from September 1, 2025 to March 31, 2026.

## 1. Who is eligible? (Eligible children)

Children born **from April 2, 2007 to March 31, 2026**.

## 2. Who can receive the payment? (Allowance recipient)

The **child allowance recipient** who cares for the eligible child/children

## 3. How much is it? (Amount)

**20,000 yen** per eligible child (one time only).

## 4. When will it be made? (Payment timing)

Payments will be made **on or after February 10, 2026**.

If you cannot confirm receipt of the payment after receiving the allowance notice, contact one of the help desks shown on the back.

Note: For those who fall under "6" on the back, payments will start from the end of February after the application is accepted.

## 5. How can I receive it? (Payment method)

(1) If you are a child allowance recipient:

**In principle**, the allowance is transferred **to the registered bank account for child allowance, or to the bank account specified in the notification of change of bank account information.**

(2) If you are a guardian who applied (who falls under “6”):

The allowance will be transferred to **the bank account specified in the application form.**

Note: If the transfer cannot be processed due to the closure or change of your bank account, or for other similar reasons, you will not receive the payment. In such cases, please call one of the contact points below.

## 6. Who needs to apply?

**You must apply if you meet any of the following conditions.**

**Please submit the application form and the necessary documents.**

- You are a public servant **receiving child allowance from your government office**
- You are a guardian who has been eligible to receive child allowance **since October 2025 because of divorce (including those under divorce mediation).**
- **You received child allowance until September 2025 and moved overseas, etc.**

## 7. What if...

### ■ What if I moved?

The allowance will be **transferred from the municipality (including special wards) that paid the child allowance for September 2025 (October for children born in September 2025)** to the bank account receiving child allowances or the bank account specified in the application form.

For any inquiries, contact the municipality where you used to live.

### ■ What if my child/children and I have fled our home due to domestic violence?

If you have already completed procedures to change the child allowance recipient in the municipality to which you have fled, you may be able to receive this one-time allowance. Contact your current municipality as soon as possible. You do not need to update your certificate of residence or contact your spouse's municipality.
